THE LOWELL HEALTHY HOMES PROGRAM, LOCATED WITHIN THE CENTER FOR COMMUNITY RESEARCH AND ENGAGEMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS LOWELL, HAD REQUESTED GRANT FUNDS IN 2014 TO PROVIDE INTERVENTIONS, AND EDUCATION TO FAMILIES IN LOWELL THAT SUFFER FROM ASTHMA. EACH OF THEIR HOMES RECEIVED AN ENVIRONMENTAL HOME ASSESSMENT, TOOLS, RESOURCES TO ADDRESS DUST MITES/PETS/MOISTURE & MOLD, IN ADDITION TO SMOKING.

OUTCOMES

- 9 HOME-BASED CHILD CARE STAFF WERE TRAINED. 12 FAMILY SERVICE WORKERS WERE ALSO TRAINED, IN ADDITION TO 5+ CENTER-BASED TEACHING STAFF.
- CTI HEALTHCARE STAFF DISSEMINATED THE
 HEALTHY HOMES PRACTICES AND
 PRINCIPLES TO 57 FAMILIES OF ASTHMATIC
 CHILDREN.
- CTI DISTRIBUTED HEALTHY HOMES SUPPLIES
 TO 63 ELIGIBLE FAMILIES (1 VACUUM WITH
 HEPA FILTER, 1 GREEN ALL-PURPOSE FILTER, 1
 GREEN GLASS CLEANER, 1 ALLERGEN PROOF
 MATTRESS COVER 1 ALLERGEN PROOF
 PILLOW COVER.)
